Other business may be transacted at the Meeting provided it is submitted in writing to the Secretary with the support, evidenced by signatures, of three other members of the Association from different households.

Will you please let the Secretary have, in writing, nominations for Officers and Committee Members for the year 1975/76 by 18 September 1975.

The Rules of the Association governing nominations and restrictions on Committee Membership are reproduced below:

Any Member of the Association shall be entitled to propose a candidate for nomination provided that the consent of the nominee is first obtained and the nomination seconded. Attendance at the Meeting of at least one of the nominee, proposer or seconder, is obligatory.

Where the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, voting shall be by ballot at the Meeting. In the election of members of the Committee, each member of the Association shall not vote for more than six nominees.

No person holding political office shall be an Officer of the Association. Political office shall be defined as:

Being a member of, or candidate for, Local or National Government, if sponsored by a recognised political organisation.

N.B. This does not preclude non-members from being nominated, but, if elected, they would, of course, have to join the Association.

The Rules of the Association may be inspected by arrangement with any Member of the Committee, whose names appear overleaf. Provision is made for the alteration of the Rules in accordance with the following Rule:

The Association shall have the power to amend, to add to, or to rescind these Rules, but no alteration shall be made except at the General Meeting of the Association and then only by a majority consisting of not less than two thirds of those present and voting at the Meeting. Notice of the proposed alteration must reach the Hon. Secretary of the Association, in writing, at least ten days before the date of the Meeting. Notice of the proposed alteration shall be given to members of the Association at least five days before the Meeting.
