The purpose of the meeting is two-fold.

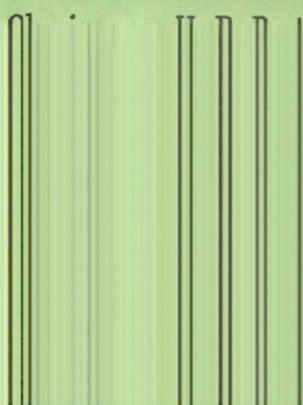
1. Committee members are urgently needed to carry on the valuable work achieved in the past. These new members can be elected at the meeting.

URGENT EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

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The V.P.R.A. was formed some considerable time ago, and since that time has played an extremely important part in protecting the interests of the residents during the expansion of the estate. At the same time, every effort has been made to increase the facilities/amenities for our members.

It has become apparant, however, from the attendance at the A.G.M. that interest in the Association has declined. Due to the fact that many of the Committee are also in the process of moving, the Committee itself is also desperately short of members, with an increase of 35% - 40% in number of residents to serve. If the Association is to survive at all in the future, this situation must be reversed immediately.

The purpose of the meeting is two-fold. Firstly, we need more Committee Members to carry on the invaluable work done in the past. Secondly, in view of the lack of interest, to ask YOU to comment upon what you would like the aims of the Committee to be in the future. For example, there is a possibility that a pre-fabricated building will be erected on the estate at the rear of Bedgebury Close, Northfleet Close, the prime function being that of a play group. We have asked the person involved to attend our meeting to discuss this further, and also to outline other uses to which the hall could be put.

So please attend. This Committee is in existence for your benefit. IF IT IS TO CONTINUE, WE IN TURN NEED YOUR INTEREST AND SUPPORT, AND ALSO YOUR OWN VIEWS.
